### SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Panels manufactured by Koreteck. Turnkey, design-build program led by the Butler Builder®, Furst Construction who worked with owners Ken and Merlynn Jones, architect John Wilhite, and Butler Manufacturing Company to design the facility.

### FEATURES:

The building includes a warehouse and distribution area and 6,250 square feet of office and showroom space. The facility features an unusual combination of wall systems that provided a unique solution for the owner's needs.

### SYSTEMS USED:

Structure: Widespan™ Structural System  
Walls: Combination of 3 systems: Masonry, 6" Koreteck™ Panelized Building System incorporating bands of glass, and Butlerib® II Wall System  
Roof: MR-24® Standing Seam Metal Roof System

### PERFORMANCE:

The Koreteck™ portion of this project was completed in 5 days. This quick installation contributed to a reduced construction schedule as it was the fastest installation of the three wall systems that comprise the facility.
